## **ENTRANCE OF THE THEOTOKOS**

According to the tradition of the Church, the Theotokos was brought to the Temple at three years of age, where she was consecrated to God and spent her days until she was fourteen or fifteen years old; and then, as a mature maiden, by the common counsel of the priests (since her parents had reposed some three years before), she was betrothed to Joseph.

#### Greetings,

As always, we'd like to start by thanking all of those who have been able to help with recent events. Our community has had a number of projects and events take place over the past year and it is difficult to remember them all. Most recently, the Harvest Festival, another gyro-drive-through, and the upcoming Philoptochos bake sale. These take time and effort to pull off and are not possible without the hard work and dedication of our community.

Next, the Parish Council was able to meet on October 13th. Topics included marketing/outreach, Taste of the Mediterranean (TOM) 2025, and more. TOM will take place on May 2, 2025, at Old Capital Inn. The committee has enlisted Chris Sarris out of Birmingham to be the DJ for the event. They are in the process of planning and preparing for the event with more information to come soon.

Marketing/Outreach was discussed at length. Our website is live post-renovation with more changes/modifications to come. Overall, it is a significant improvement and we hope to utilize its functionality for existing parishioners and future visitors. On that same note, we agreed to proceed with a six-month marketing campaign at \$1,000 a month. This campaign will initially be run through social media (Facebook and Instagram) and focus on young families living within a twenty-mile radius of the church. Ads will feature photos and text touting our unchanging faith in an ever-changing world. Traffic will be driven to the website where viewers can find more information about the church and faith. The media section will allow viewers to watch services, listen to certain ministries, or only watch the sermon as needed (more coming). The hope is that they will then take the next step and visit our church.

This brings us to the most important aspect of growth. We have started and completed a number of large projects in the past year. We have increased the number of events and stepped up outreach. Our parish has seen an increased commitment to attending those events and services. However, we must now show the community who we are as Orthodox Christians. Discuss the faith with those outside of our parish. Bring others into the church. Pack the church for services and ministries and show visitors who we are.

## **GOYA**




